April 13, 2011

MINUTES

The Board of the Ohio Law Library Consortium ("OLLC") convened a meeting at approximately 3:00 p.m. on April 13, 2011 at the Ohio Judicial Center in Columbus, Ohio. Board members in attendance included Chair Galen Avery, Immediate Past Chair Mary Jenkins, Vice-Chair Linda Hostetler, and Secretary Kathleen M. Sasala. OLLC Members included Keith Blough (Franklin County), Heather Ebert (Marion County), and Nancy Flautt (Perry County). Linda Hostetler indicated that she will be retiring soon but can stay on as Vice-Chair until the October meeting.

Galen Avery called for approval of the Minutes of the October 21, 2010 meeting of the OLLC Board and membership. Upon motion of Mary Jenkins, seconded by Kathleen M. Sasala, those Minutes were unanimously approved with amendments to the title and date of the printed copy of those Minutes, a copy of which is attached hereto.

Galen Avery then provided a report on the OLLC Court Rules project, indicating that the rules of 12 new jurisdictions have been added.

Mary Jenkins then provided an update on the new Municipal Court Ordinances project, which is a subset of Ohio's participation in AALL's State Working Groups to Ensure Access to Electronic Legal Information. There are approximately 20 people working on various codes throughout Ohio to determine, *inter alia*, whether they are online, official, authenticated and permanent. Eventually, all information that is collected will be provided to AALL. In addition, by late May, all online Ohio links should be posted on the OLLC website at [ollc.wikispaces.com](http://ollc.wikispaces.com).


Mary Jenkins then provided an update on the Pocket Part Exchange, which is going well and enjoying greater library participation, including assistance from the Law Library at the Salmon P. Chase College of Law at Northern Kentucky University. Although more titles are being shared, not all requests were fulfilled.

Kathleen M. Sasala then summarized her Ill report, a copy of which is attached hereto. Ms. Sasala and Mary Jenkins both commented that statistics are actually under-reported because a lot of unofficial activity is being conducted both on and off the ORALL-C list without being reported to the OLLC.

At the next meeting, Linda Hostetler would like to discuss reducing Board meetings to twice a year to coincide with the ORALL SIG Spring retreat and the annual ORALL conference. Alternatively, Ms. Sasala suggested 2 electronic and 2 in-person meetings.

There being no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
